Project Title: New Well #8 and Pipeline Replacement Project

SCH Number: To be assigned

Project Location: The Frazier Park Public Utilities District (FPPUD) is located in the southern San Joaquin Valley, just west of Interstate-5 and north of the Los Angeles and Kern Counties' boundary within Kern County. The proposed Project consists of installation of a new well, west of the intersection of Mt. Pinos Way and Frazier Mountain Park Road and immediately south of Frazier Mountain Park Road. This proposed Project also includes replacement of about 18,300 lineal feet of existing potable water distribution lines. The project area occupies a portion of Section 36, Township 9 North, Range 20 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian. The Longitude/Latitude at the center of the District is 118°N 56'58"/34°W 49'20".

Project Description: The Frazier Park Public Utilities District (FPPUD or District) is proposing to implement two water infrastructure Projects in the near future for which the District is seeking funding from the State Water Resources Control Board's Division of Drinking Water (DDW). The first Project is a new potable water well, proposed District Well #8. The second Project is the replacement of approximately 18,300 feet of District potable water distribution pipelines in three of the District's service areas, Summit Area, Lower Summit Area, and Texas Trail.

Project Sponsor(s): Frazier Park Public Utilities District

This is to advise that the Frazier Park Public Utilities District, acting as the lead agency, has prepared an Initial Study to determine if the project may have a significant effect on the environment and is proposing to adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration based on the following finding:
